First use:

Parenthetical: ... end of sentence (Robbins, 2014).

Signal phrase: Robbins (2014) states that ...

Second and additional uses:

Parenthetical: ... end of sentence (Robbins, 2014).

Signal phrase: Robbins (2014) states that ...

End-of-paper citations

Reference

Robbins, R. H. (2014). *Global problems and the culture of capitalism*, (6th ed.). Boston, MA: Pearson.

**Special Note:** In APA, note that only 1<sup>st</sup> word of a title, 1<sup>st</sup> word of a subtitle and proper nouns are capitalized in titles. Exception: Names of journals.

**Special Note:** If only one source is used label the end-of-paper citation section as Reference. Use the plural form, References, when 2+ sources are used in-text.

**Special Note:** The standard APA format style for references is double-spaced, indented 2+ lines, and typed on a new page. In this class only we will ignore this formatting to save space.
