Page numbers would be located at the bottom. Look for the number on first and last pages to get the range.

Note: Even though the original article title was capitalized, only first word of title, first word of subtitle and proper nouns are capitalized.

Here is the citation (APA):

Note: Names of journals are different. All words ARE capitalized EXCEPT for prepositions (i.e.; of, by, for, along), articles (i.e.; the, a, an) and conjunctions (i.e., and, after, before) UNLESS they are the first word of the title or subtitle.
