What is an Academic Journal Article?

- These are the criteria I use to determine if a source is an academic journal article, useful for this class:
 1. Is the source published in an academic journal?
 2. Is the source at least 5 pages long? [Some journal articles are shorter, but in this class 5 pages is a minimum.]
 3. Is there at least one reference used in the source?
- When is a source in a journal NOT academic.
 - Often book reviews are found in journals; do not count these as academic journal articles.
 - Sometimes there is commentary about an issue in a journal; it is not peer reviewed, not original research. Does not count. One hint that something is a commentary is that the page length is 1-2 pages and there are no references used.

If you are looking for journal articles you might use JSTOR.

If you have a preferred format, you may choose to bypass this page by setting your [Preferences](#) option at any time. **PDF format is recommended for most users.**

PDF Format (Recommended):

[High Quality PDF](#) - Larger file size with high-quality images and resolution. This format allows users to copy and paste text, find words and phrases in the article, and is suitable for use with screen readers such as JAWS.

[Economy PDF](#) - Smaller file size with fax-quality resolution.

The PDF printing option requires the use of a PDF reader. If you have problems viewing the High Quality PDF, please try [Adobe Reader](#), version 5 or above.

NOTE: If you are a Windows user, right click the desired format and select "Save Link As..." (in Firefox or Netscape) or "Save Target As..." (in Internet Explorer). If you are a Mac user, right click on the link or ctrl + click on the link and choose "Download Link Target as" or "Download Link to disk."

I always like to download articles so I have a copy on my computer. If you prefer a hard copy, you can always print it later.

TIFF Format:

[TIFF Format](#) - This image based file type is designed for use with assistive technology such as document scanner/readers like Kurzweil, OCR programs, or screen magnifiers.

NOTE: If you are not prompted with "File Download" dialog box, you can right-click (Shift-F10) the link in order to activate the context menu. Click or arrow down to the "Save Target As..." option. Ensure that the file is saved with a .tif extension, rather than .tiff.

Special Note: If you have a pdf version of an article, do not use the APA reference format for an electronically delivered source (you have the original so simplify your citing.
