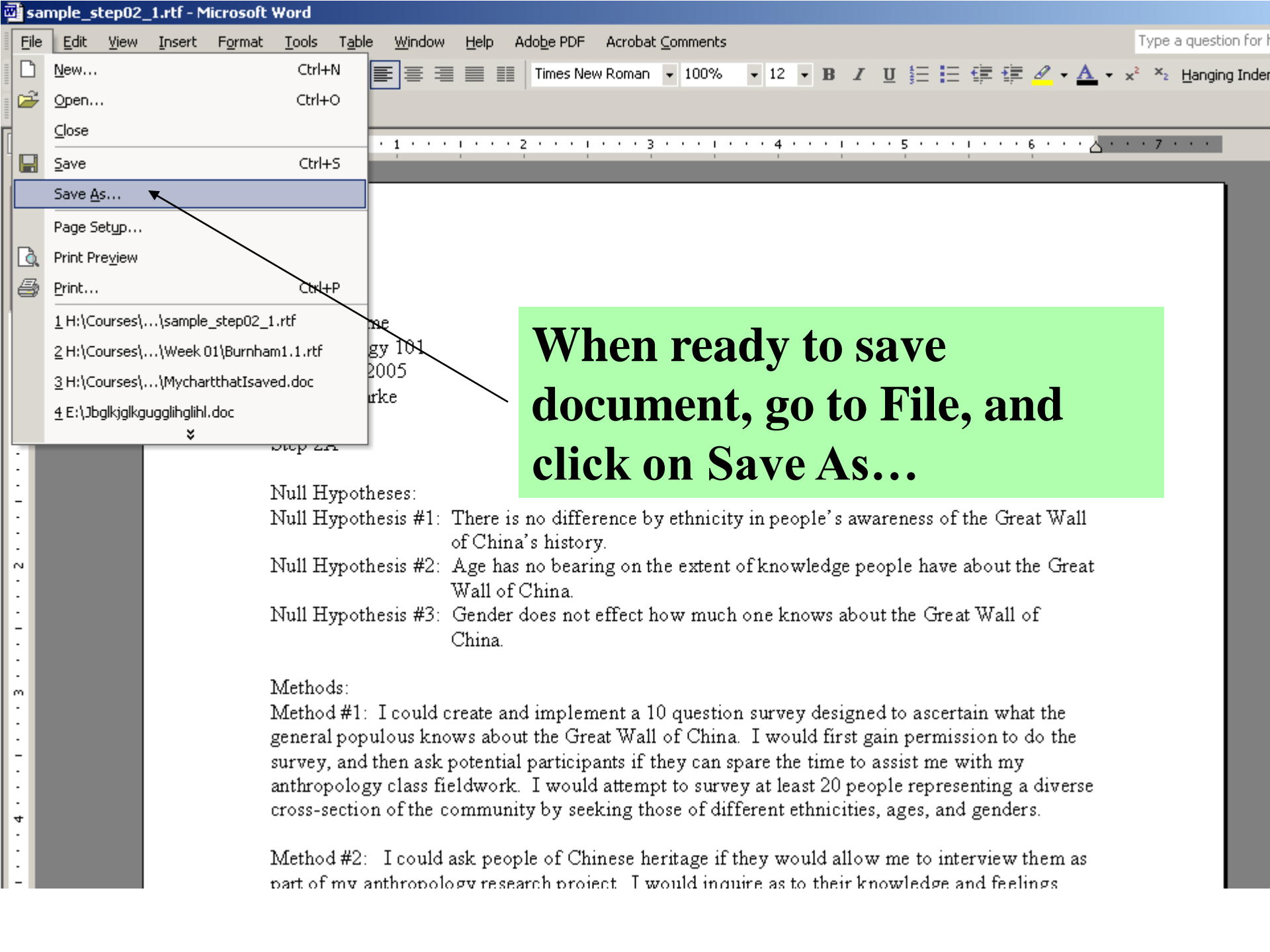


How to Save Document as rtf



When ready to save document, go to File, and click on Save As...

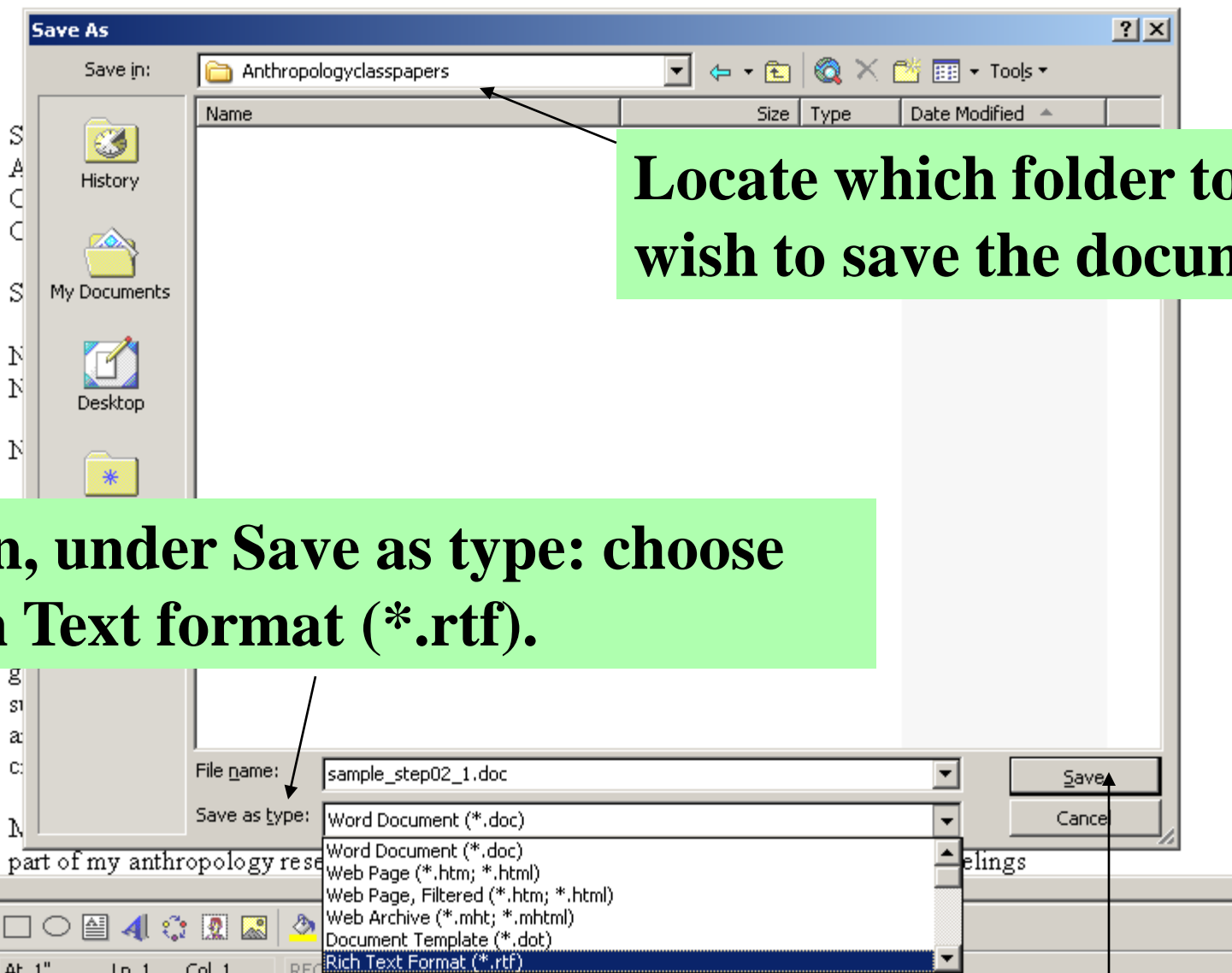
Null Hypotheses:

- Null Hypothesis #1: There is no difference by ethnicity in people's awareness of the Great Wall of China's history.
- Null Hypothesis #2: Age has no bearing on the extent of knowledge people have about the Great Wall of China.
- Null Hypothesis #3: Gender does not effect how much one knows about the Great Wall of China.

Methods:

Method #1: I could create and implement a 10 question survey designed to ascertain what the general populous knows about the Great Wall of China. I would first gain permission to do the survey, and then ask potential participants if they can spare the time to assist me with my anthropology class fieldwork. I would attempt to survey at least 20 people representing a diverse cross-section of the community by seeking those of different ethnicities, ages, and genders.

Method #2: I could ask people of Chinese heritage if they would allow me to interview them as part of my anthropology research project. I would inquire as to their knowledge and feelings
